

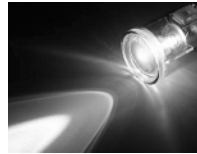

Not all shake flashlights are created equal! A shakelight buying guide

Perhaps you have seen less expensive shake flashlights for sale at your local hardware store, or perhaps you have seen great deals on the internet. How are you supposed to tell the difference between a quality shake flashlight and an expensive fridge magnet?

1. Cost...

The components that affect the quality and performance of a shake flashlight include the quality of the LED element (in terms of its brightness & efficiency), the strength of the magnet that moves through the coil when shaken, the number of windings in the coil (more will create a greater charge with each shake), and the quality & size of the capacitor that stores the charge. To save cost, some manufacturers use the cheapest, least reliable components they can find. The result is a cheap flashlight that only provides a weak light source for a few minutes at a time, and likely will not survive years of use. Shakelights under \$15 typically fall into this category.

The Generation:20 & Generation:60 models have been designed with careful attention to each of these core components, with some being made specifically for these flashlights. The result being two of the best shake flashlights available at any price.

2. Duration...

If you see a flashlight that states "3-5 minutes of light from 30 seconds of shaking", what you are getting is light that will only be reasonably bright for about 1 minute before it starts to discharge significantly. The result is that you will likely be spending more time shaking the flashlight than actually using it as a flashlight! Don't be fooled by trusted brand names either - all 5 minute flashlights are the same. A fancy label cannot magically produce more electricity.

Our Generation:20 & Generation:60 shakelights are 20+ minute & 60+ minute flashlights respectively. They are brightest for the first 5 & 20 minutes, but provide useable light right up to their stated durations. As far as shake flashlights go, these are top performers.

3. Warranty...

If it doesn't come with a warranty that the retailer can or will support, leave it on the shelf. We back our Generation flashlights for 6 years, and will pay for warranty exchange shipping if there appears a defect in workmanship within the first 30 days of use.
